Union Gospel Mission

Union Gospel Mission Twin Cities (UGMTC) opened its doors more than 120 years ago to feed, shelter and share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with Saint Paul dock workers, laborers and lumberjacks.

Today, their emergency shelter provides guests with food, shelter and vital care—including mental health services. Once immediate needs are met, the staff walk alongside residents for up to two years, providing Bible study, licensed therapists, adult education, mentorship, job-skills training, and financial skills instruction needed to thrive and live successfully in the community.

Faith formation is at the core of UGMTC. They believe that encountering the Gospel of Jesus leads to life transformation. As they address the core issues that lead to homelessness, trauma and addiction, spiritual health is central to experiencing healing and wholeness.

Those who are new to faith are encouraged to become followers of Jesus Christ. For those who have taken steps of faith, UGMTC walks with them as they deepen their relationship with Jesus. They offer chapel services, Bible studies, devotions and chaplain support. The Mission has held a chapel service every night since 1902. Services include worship, teaching, prayer and connection with others. Volunteers and staff members also provide Bible studies during the day and evenings. Our chaplains offer spiritual support to all guests and residents.

UGMTC chaplains are involved in every program at the Mission, including the emergency shelter. Holistic care is supported on every level by our chaplains. The vision of the chaplains is to "invite people to the love of Jesus by being conduits of hope through humility."
